Individuals should have the freedom to use public and private funding to enroll in non-degree programs that unlock meaningful career opportunities.

Policy reforms: individualized funding accounts, student loan alternatives, employer upskilling, accreditation barriers, workforce development funding



ELIMINATE BARRIERS TO WORKFORCE PARTICIPATION

When employers value a person's experience, skills, and motivation to contribute, it unearths a vast supply of talent in places employers seldom look. Current policies and practices favor degrees and disincentivize people from contributing. Individuals can achieve social and economic mobility when policymakers remove barriers that prevent them from fully leveraging their skills and aptitudes.


